Earthquake Victims in Haiti**

**Fundraiser to Benefit Doctors Without Borders/Médecins Sans
Frontières on Saturday, January 16, 2010
at Moka Night Club & Lounge**

January 13, 2010 - New York, NY - The devastating news that has struck the Diaspora about the 7.0 Earthquake that damaged the capital of Haiti on Tuesday, January 12, 2010 has given **Jaz Enterprise**, alongside **Young Quality Entertainment** cause to cancel the **2nd Annual All Black Affair** featuring Kompa artists T-Vice and Harmonik scheduled for this upcoming **Saturday, January 16, 2010**. Through heartfelt thought, instead these two entities have joined forces with **Doctors Without Borders/Médecins Sans Frontières** to host a Fundraiser at New York's **Moka Night Club & Lounge** in hopes of reinforcing the Diaspora's commitment to those in Haiti.

Doctors Without Borders/Médecins Sans Frontières (MSF) is an international medical humanitarian organization created by doctors and journalists in France in 1971. Today, **Doctors Without Borders/Médecins Sans Frontières** provides aid in nearly 60 countries to people whose survival is threatened by violence,

neglect, or catastrophe, primarily due to armed conflict, epidemics, malnutrition, exclusion from health care, or natural disasters. **Doctors Without Borders/Médecins Sans Frontières** provides independent, impartial assistance to those most in need and in 1999, they were honored to receive the Nobel Peace Prize.

Doctors Without Borders/Médecins Sans Frontières has a long history of providing urgent medical assistance in Haiti. Their medical facilities were badly damaged during the earthquake, but hundreds of MSF staff on the ground are working to treat earthquake survivors and meet the huge needs that are only beginning to emerge from this human catastrophe.

Paul McPhun, MSF's operations manager for Haiti said, "We have altogether around 800 medical staff working in Haiti. Thirty of those are international. We're currently putting rapid response plans into place based out of North America and out of Europe to have another 70 international staff available over the next few days with specialties to be able to respond to these more immediate emergency medical needs. Likewise, we're prepared now and have prepared freight, including an emergency inflatable hospital so we can set up exactly those services we're currently missing. We're strongly identified in Haiti with emergency medical care—even our coordination offices are becoming centers of influx for people in neighborhoods with severe trauma wounds."

As a means of solidarity, local artists have pledged to support the cause and New York based DJ's, Media Affiliates and Personalities have also vowed to band together to collect monetary donations that will go entirely (100%) to **Doctors Without Borders/Médecins Sans Frontières** as the organization will disburse the funds to those ravished by this terrible natural disaster in Haiti.

All Black attire is welcomed as it will show limitless respect for those in mourning from the loss of many who have been directly affected by the disastrous events which took place on Tuesday. With several performances planned in a show of mutual support, the evening has been set aside from **6pm** to allow all those who are interested in sharing their talents to raise much needed funds for the country and its people. The event will be broadcast live on Minkoze.com.

Monetary donations in the form of check and money order made out to **Doctors Without Borders/Médecins Sans Frontières** will be accepted at the door in lieu of an admission fee.

The tragic events that we are still trying to cope with this week have paralyzed us mentally and emotionally but on **Saturday, January 16, 2010** the New York community at large will have an opportunity to start the relief effort early to guarantee that

aid, supplies, medication and much needed attention is given to the people of Haiti.

Also, be advised that those individuals or groups who have already purchased tickets to the original All Black Affair are directed to return to the location where the tickets were purchased to obtain a refund.
